Evenings were spent enjoying meals at local restaurants—including Hard Rock Café—and unwinding at the hotel. From exploring the Olympic Park's interactive exhibits to relaxing on the beach, every moment delivered a fresh experience. One standout day was our visit to Aquapolis water park, where students had the time of their lives sliding, swimming and singing along on the coach. The trip wrapped up with free time in a local park, a final lunch, and last-minute shopping before flying home. - 'First Give' Charity Finals (see lower right)— three year 12 teams have participated in this social action project, where students choose a local charity and run a campaign to raise awareness. Judging on the finals day were Counsellor Ali from the Hainault Ward and two of our alumni, both currently studying Architecture at University in London. Well done to the winning team, who were campaigning for 'Woodford and Wanstead Migrant Support' and who donated the prize-winning sum of £1000!
