## Recent highlights:

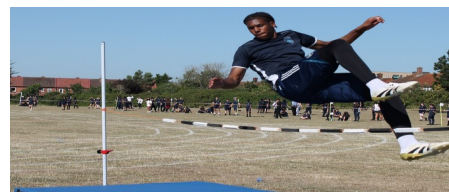

We wish all TFA students and their families a wonderful summer holiday, and see below right for details of when the school re-opens in September.

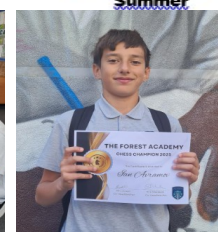
